## Lappeenranta Lakeland International Airport

IATA: LPP, ICAO: EFLP

- Airport is located only two kilometers from the Lappeenranta city center
- Runway length is 2.500 meters long and 60 meters wide
- The airport has been established in 1918 and it is the oldest operating airport in Finland
- The airport is owned by the City of Lappeenranta
- Short waiting and taxi times reduce the emissions and costs
- Currently Ryanair operates two weekly services to Milan-Bergamo, Italy














## Lappeenranta Airport passenger volume development 2010-2022


